From the Dean & Director of Libraries



Each fall brings a sense of renewed energy to all of us in the University Libraries as we begin a

new academic year with a sense of excitement at the return of students and a sense of pleasure in what we have accomplished to enhance our libraries and improve our services.

Our much-needed renovation of the University Library reference area is now completed. The new "Information Commons" offers students more computer workstations and allows greater access to our electronic resources. We have, once again, expanded our information literacy instruction, so that more students can learn how to access and evaluate the world of information available in the Libraries and on the Internet.

The University Library now has a wonderful new signage system to make navigating this large building easier for everyone. Some of you were able to join us in June, for the University's

celebration of Alumni Weekend at the downtown campus. We welcomed hundreds of visitors to the Dewey Library to see the splendid improvements we've made there. The stained-glass windows are now breathtaking: the lighted windows at night, for those passing by, are clear and pristine, and the clear glass exterior covers will protect and preserve the windows for the enjoyment of many future generations.

During Alumni Weekend, the New Library was host to the unveiling of the murals depicting the long history of the University. The murals will be permanently installed in the lobby of the New Library later this year. Library staff and student assistants and the University Archives played key roles in the development of these interesting murals.

When I meet with colleagues from other academic libraries, I am always proud to talk about the dynamic and supportive group of volunteers who work for Albany's Libraries — the Friends of the Libraries. The Friends continue to raise funds, support special projects, and advance the Libraries through sponsored programs. Last year, the Friends sponsored a delightful Community Conversation on "The Art of Creating New York State Public Policy," a panel discussion among four distinguished historians and biographers, who engaged in a lively discussion about major political figures who shaped the lives of New Yorkers and the nation.

The Friends continue their ambitious programming this year, co-sponsoring talks by Pulitzer-prize winning author William Kennedy, historian and

biographer Joseph Persico '52, and research scholar/mystery writer Frankie Y. Bailey, Professor in the School of Criminal Justice. Our Friends bring the Libraries accolades as they promote the spirit of intellectual inquiry.

In a difficult year, Albany's Libraries continued to receive generous support from a great many donors. In a year that nationwide saw some downturns in giving, we were fortunate to add eight new members to the President's Club. We were also fortunate to double the size of our Library Development Committee. These dedicated friends and alumni have made great progress in helping us formulate goals and plans for the upcoming University capital campaign.

It is especially gratifying that many of Albany's Librarians have received national recognition for the quality of their research, which is being published in some of the top journals in our field. Specific information about the accomplishments of our library faculty is inside these pages, in "UL in the News."

It is a distinct pleasure to have staff, students, faculty, alumni, and volunteers who support the Albany's Libraries with such passion. All have renewed our energy and sustained our hope and our optimism as we work together to make the University Libraries the measure of the University at Albany's vitality in the 21st century.

Librarians Participate in ACRL's Best Practices in Information Literacy Conference

UAlbany was one of just 10 institutions chosen to participate in the Best Practices in Information Literacy Invitational Conference held in Atlanta in June, 2002. The University was represented by Librarians **Carol Ann Germain**, **Trudi Jacobson**, and **Lijuan Xu**, and by **Thomas Mackey** of the School of Information Science and Policy. All teach courses that meet the University's general education information literacy requirement. According to Trudi Jacobson, "Students must learn where to look on the Internet and how to do so critically. They must be able to discriminate among the vast array of sources, and develop an effective context for what they find."

Last year, University Libraries offered 42 sections of UNL to 639 students. It is anticipated that in 2002-2003, 650-750 students will take the Libraries' literacy course, along with UNL 206, a new course in Science Information Literacy. But more courses

are needed, says Jacobson, and "one best practice is to integrate information literacy into discipline-based courses, particularly for majors, where students learn these skills in context." Science Library Writers' Colloquia

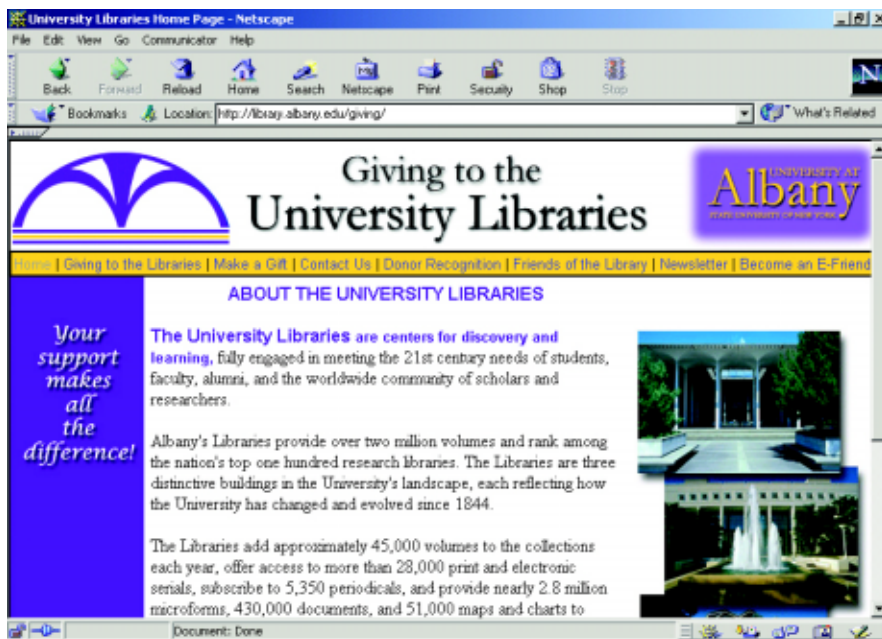
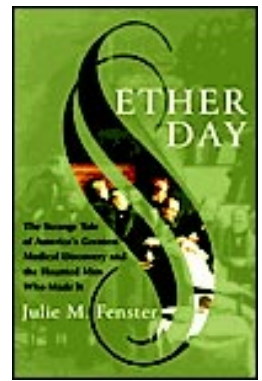
The Science Library's colloquia series began with a celebration of "Ether Day" on October 16. Julie M. Fenster, author of *Ether Day: The Strange Tale of America's Greatest Medical Discovery and the Haunted Men Who Made It*, spoke at the first program in the series for this fall.

October 16, 1846 was the day that the first surgical procedure was performed using anesthesia. The operation took place at Massachusetts General Hospital, and this day was celebrated around the world as "Ether Day." The medical uses of ether were a dramatic success — so much so that the three men, former partners, fought bitterly for each to claim the discovery for himself.

The battle was ferocious: all three lost control, and each ended up ruined. The talk was followed by a reception for the author.

On April 3, 2003, Professor Jon Beckwith, Harvard Medical School, will speak about his new memoir, *Making Waves: A Social Activist in Science*. Dr. Beckwith, one of the co-discoverers of the technique used for isolating genes, makes the case in his memoir that scientists have a special responsibility to be socially active and promote the public understanding of science.

Gregg Sapp, head of the Science Library, believes that "these talks and others like them will find receptive audiences among the UA community." What's New in Grenander Collections and Archives

Two recent collection agreements promise an intriguing array of public history documents for scholars and researchers. WAMC, local public radio and National Public Radio affiliate, has named the University at Albany the official repository of the radio station's programs, newsletters, photographs, and other archival materials. WAMC produces more nationally syndicated programs than any other NPR affiliate, second only to the DC-based home station. Some of these programs include "The Best of Our Knowledge," "The Book Show," "The Capital Connection," and "The Environment Show." Many of these programs include prominent researchers and scholars from the University as well as other nationally recognized figures. Additional recordings, which date back to 1977, include special events, folk festivals, and coverage for local and state political events.

The Archives of Public Affairs and Policy is also pleased to announce the acquisition of the Alice P. Green Papers, which constitute the writings, career, activities, and history of events in the life of Dr. Alice Green from 1965-2001. Green is a well-known and highly respected political activist whose most acclaimed work has been in the criminal justice area, in which she has worked tirelessly to promote prison reform and advocate on behalf of prisoners. Dr. Green has always worked to advance civil liberties and human rights. She is the founder and the current executive director of the Center for Law and Justice in Albany. Brian Keough, Head of the Grenander Special Collections and Archives, says that this acquisition is "just an incredible enrichment to our archives. Her papers augment other collections, including National Death Penalty Archives, that are related to state-wide and national political and social movements of the late 20th century."

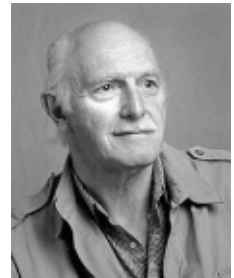

People Who Give — Georgiana Panton



As a lifelong supporter of libraries as well as a person who worked for Governor Rockefeller's office when the uptown University campus was

conceived and built, Georgiana Panton is a natural for membership in the Library Development Committee.

"My first job was in the Art and Music Department of Syracuse Public Library. To this day, I still like that job more than any job I've ever had," she says. "I paid for my college education through my work in the library; I went to Syracuse University, but only because there was no nearby public university."

Georgiana Panton's interest in college was political science. She was awarded a scholarship to the Maxwell School, earned a Master's in public administration, and came to Albany to work in Governor Rockefeller's Program Office. She worked there for three years. One of her jobs was communicating with people in the country club that was acquired, through eminent domain, by the state to be made into

the present uptown campus. "It was a great time to work in government. We felt a collective sense of improving the world. We felt that government truly worked for the betterment of its citizens, and we wanted to be a part of that great process."

Panton's subsequent work with the state kept her involved in both government and the university. She continued graduate work in political science at the University at Albany. She worked as a research associate with a professor in the School of Criminal Justice, and later, during legislative sessions, she worked in the Legislative Reference Library of the New York State Library compiling bibliographies for legislators. "You can see that I never strayed too far from libraries," she says now.

The Panton family has been part of the University at Albany for decades. Jim Panton '53, '87, has long been active with the University, and currently serves as chairman of the University at Albany Foundation's Community Council. Their daughter, Diane Panton '83, went on to earn her M.D. with special distinction in research from Stony Brook in 1987.

Everyone in the family is committed to public higher education: Jim earned two degrees; son James earned his first BA degree from the University at Buffalo and a Master's degree in civil engineering from UMass, Amherst. Both Georgiana and Jim Panton have been very active at the University Art Museum, and have traveled to Cuba to facilitate last year's exhibit, "Passionately Cuban."

After retiring in 1995 as Director of Personnel for the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles, Georgiana Panton was able to devote more energy to the kinds of civic involvement that appeal to her. She was for nine years a member of the Rensselaer County Council for the Arts, and

in fact "was part of the strategic planning group that was responsible for a new vision as well as a name change to the Arts Center of the Capital Region." She has worked for years bringing wonderful music to the Capital District, and was President of Vanguard-Albany Symphony. She currently serves on the board of Troy Chromatics Concerts, which are given in the world-famous Troy Music Hall. She is a member of the Empire State Plaza Art Commission, and has served several terms as a board member and officer for Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood.

In all these organizations, Panton's work has mostly been in fundraising. "I guess I'm getting typecasted," she says. She and Jim have been President's

Club members for a long time, and have every intention of maintaining their financial support to the University as well as their commitments of time and energy.

And perhaps she is, because Georgiana

Panton is very clear about what she believes. "I'd like to see graduates have a greater sense of pride and also obligation for their University. Public universities need to work toward this: we all need to remember that future generations deserve the same opportunity we had through public education."

That same spirit of idealism she had when she came to work for the Rockefeller administration prevails. "I'd like to see my grandkids go to public universities. Given a choice, we want to stay with public higher education."

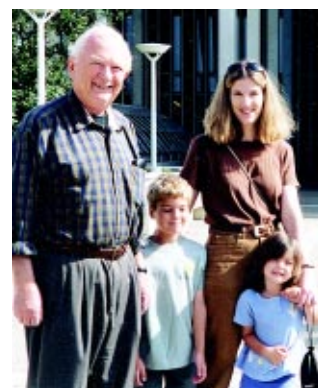

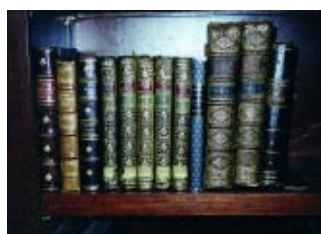
